Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Baku Airport (05.07.24)

Morning/Afternoon:

- Arrival in Heydar Aliyev International Airport: Upon arrival, you will be greeted by your guide/driver.
- Transfer to Baku: Enjoy a comfortable ride to your hotel in Baku.
- Evening:
- Hotel Check-In: Get settled into your hotel.
- Free Time: Depending on your arrival time, you can either rest or explore the nearby area at your own pace. Baku has many charming cafes and restaurants to unwind in.

Day 2: Baku City Tour (06.07.24)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- - Morning: Explore the Old City (Inner City), a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See ancient walls, the Palace of the Shirvanshahs, and the Maiden Tower.
- Afternoon: Visit Nizami Street for shopping. Enjoy an evening city tour with stops at Highland Park (Alley of Martyrs), the National Assembly (Milli Majlis), and the Flame Towers.
- - Evening: Visit Baku Crystal Hall near National Flag Square. Take a leisurely walk along Baku Boulevard with views of the Caspian Sea.

Day 3: Tsaghkadzor and Sevan Lake (07.07.24)

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Full Day: Journey to Gabala, known for its scenic beauty and attractions.
- Visit Tufandag Winter-Summer Tourism Complex for cable car rides, skiing, and picturesque landscapes.
- Explore Nohur Lake, a serene spot nestled amidst the mountains.
- Discover Yeddi Gozel (Seven Beauties) Waterfalls, a series of cascades amidst lush forests, offering breathtaking views and a chance to explore nature's beauty.

Day 4: Atesgah and Yanardag Tour (08.07.24)

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Morning: Visit Ateshgah (Fire Worshippers Temple), a historic site dating back to the 17th-18th centuries, known for its Hindu and Zoroastrian roots.
- Afternoon: Journey to Yanardag (Fire Mountain), a natural gas fire continuously burning on the Absheron Peninsula. Witness flames dancing on rocks and experience the mystical atmosphere of this unique natural phenomenon.

Day 5: Departure (09.07.24)

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Check-Out and Transfer to Airport: Depending on your flight time, you will be transferred to Baku Airport for your departure.

Package Cost: The package cost is based on a minimum of 4 adults and 1 child traveling together. If the number of travelers decreases, the package cost will vary and increase accordingly. Quotation Changes: The quotation is subject to change for reasons beyond our control, such as changes in hotel tariffs, increases in transportation costs, fuel price hikes, and changes in local taxes. Room Allocation: Accommodation is based on 2 double rooms with an extra bed or similar. Exchange Rate Variations: Any increase in the rate of exchange leading to an increase in all land arrangements may come into effect before departure. Rate of Exchange (ROE): Calculated at 1 USD = AED 3.67. The prevailing exchange rate on the final payment day will be considered. Tour Extension: Extension of the tour is subject to the availability of flights and hotels. **Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations made 45 or more working days prior to departure will incur a 50% cancellation charge of the total package cost. Cancellations made within 35-45 working days prior to departure will incur an 80% cancellation charge of the total package cost. Cancellations made within 30 working days prior to departure will incur a 100% cancellation charge of the total package cost.
