Detailed Day-Wise Itinerary:

Day 01: Arrival Cochin – Munnar (130 KM)

Upon your arrival at Cochin Airport, you will be warmly greeted by our representative. You will then embark on a scenic drive to Munnar, a picturesque hill station nestled at an altitude of 1600 meters above sea level. Known for its colonial charm from the British era, Munnar is renowned for its lush tea plantations, rolling hills, and charming valleys. Upon arrival, check into your resort and take some time to unwind and relax in this tranquil setting.

Day 02: Munnar Local Sightseeing

After a hearty breakfast, prepare to explore the natural beauty of Munnar. Your day will begin with a visit to the sprawling tea gardens, followed by a trip to Mattupetty Lake and Dam, where you can enjoy the serene waters and surrounding landscapes. Continue to Echo Point and Kundale Lake for breathtaking views and photo opportunities. A visit to Blossom Garden will add a touch of vibrant flora to your day. Conclude your sightseeing with a trip to Rajamalai, home to the endangered Nilgiri Thar mountain goat. Return to your resort for an overnight stay.

Day 03: Munnar – Thekkady (100 KM)

After breakfast, check out from the resort and drive to Thekkady, a region renowned for its undulating hills and spice plantations. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and prepare for an afternoon filled with local cultural experiences. You may choose to enjoy an elephant ride and witness cultural performances such as Kathakali and Kalarippayattu. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 04: Thekkady – Alleppey (145 KM)

After breakfast, check out from your resort and drive to Alleppey. Here, you will board a private houseboat for a leisurely cruise through the tranquil backwaters. The houseboats, known as 'Kettuvalloms,' are well-appointed with comfortable bedrooms and bathrooms. During your cruise, you can relax on the deck, enjoy the picturesque surroundings, and observe the unique lifestyle of the backwater communities. Meals will be served on the boat at no additional cost. Spend the night aboard the houseboat, soaking in the serene ambiance.

Day 05: Alleppey – Kovalam (160 KM)

Following breakfast, check out from the houseboat and drive to Kovalam, a renowned beach destination in Kerala. En route, you will visit the Jadayu Earth Centre, also known as Jatayu Nature Park, which features the world's largest bird sculpture, Jatayu. Upon arrival in Kovalam, check into your hotel and spend the rest of the day relaxing on the beautiful crescent-shaped beaches separated by rocky headlands. Enjoy a leisurely evening at the resort.

Day 06: Kovalam – Kanyakumari (85 KM)

After breakfast, set out for a drive to Kanyakumari. On the way, visit the Wooden Palace and Sucheendram Temple, two significant cultural landmarks. Once in Kanyakumari, visit the Kanyakumari Rock and take in the stunning views. In the evening, return to Kovalam via Poovar. Enjoy an overnight stay at your Kovalam resort.

Day 07: Trivandrum Airport/Railway Station Departure

On your final day, explore the vibrant city of Trivandrum. Visit the Pathmanabhaswami Temple, the Zoo, Museum, and Art Gallery, or relax at Shankumukham Beach. In the evening, you will be dropped off at Trivandrum Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey.

Note: Ensure you are at the airport at least 2 hours before your flight.

Important Notes: -

- **Accommodation in Munnar and Thekkady:** Air-conditioned rooms are not provided due to low temperatures, except in premium and luxury category hotels and resorts.
- **Hotel Check-in/Check-out:** Standard check-in and check-out times at the hotel are 12:00 hrs.
- **Houseboat Check-in/Check-out:** Check-in time is 12:00 hrs. and check-out time is 09:00 hrs. The houseboat will be stationary from 18:00 to 07:00 due to government restrictions. In A/C Deluxe Category Houseboats, air conditioning will be available from 21:00 to 06:00.
- **Sightseeing Schedule:** Sightseeing will be conducted as per the timings of travel.
- **Forest Resort Stay:** Cultural activities are not possible if staying inside a forest resort, as gates close after 17:00 (e.g., KTDC Periyar House, KTDC Aranya Nivas, and Lake Palace).
- **Kondai Lip Backwater Resort:** Guests can enjoy 2.5 hours of complimentary boating. Other sightseeing is limited as return to the resort must be before 15:00. Backwater sightseeing can be arranged instead.
- **Monuments:** All monuments are closed on Mondays.
- **Rajamalai Closure:** Rajamalai is closed from February to April, depending on the breeding period of the goats.
